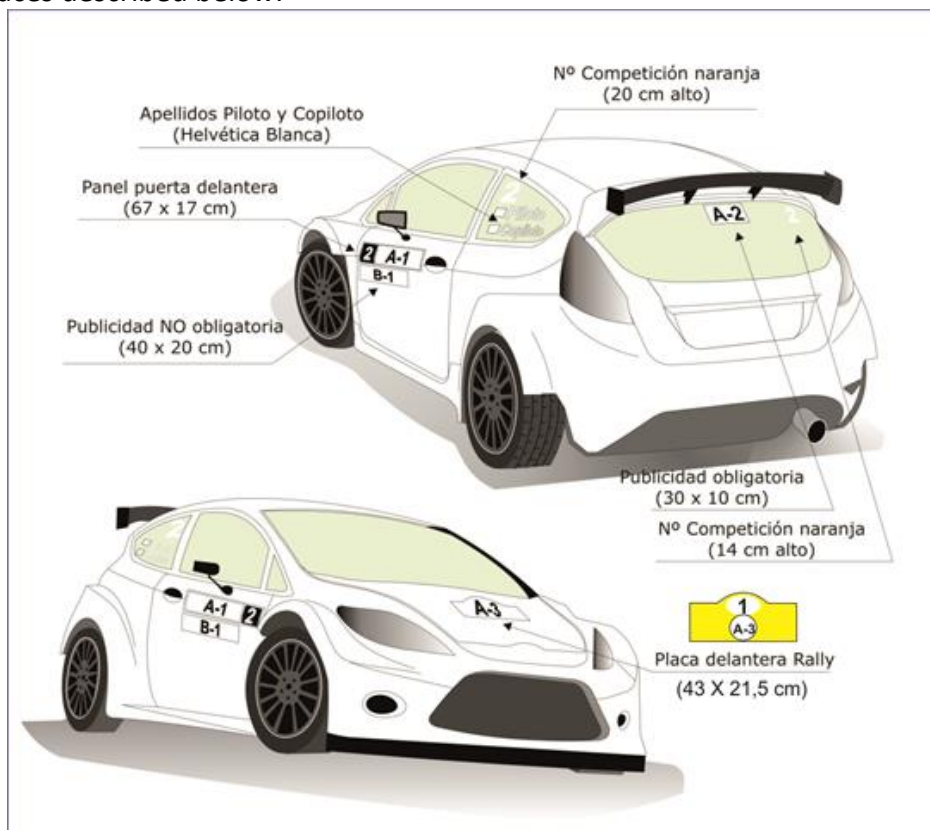

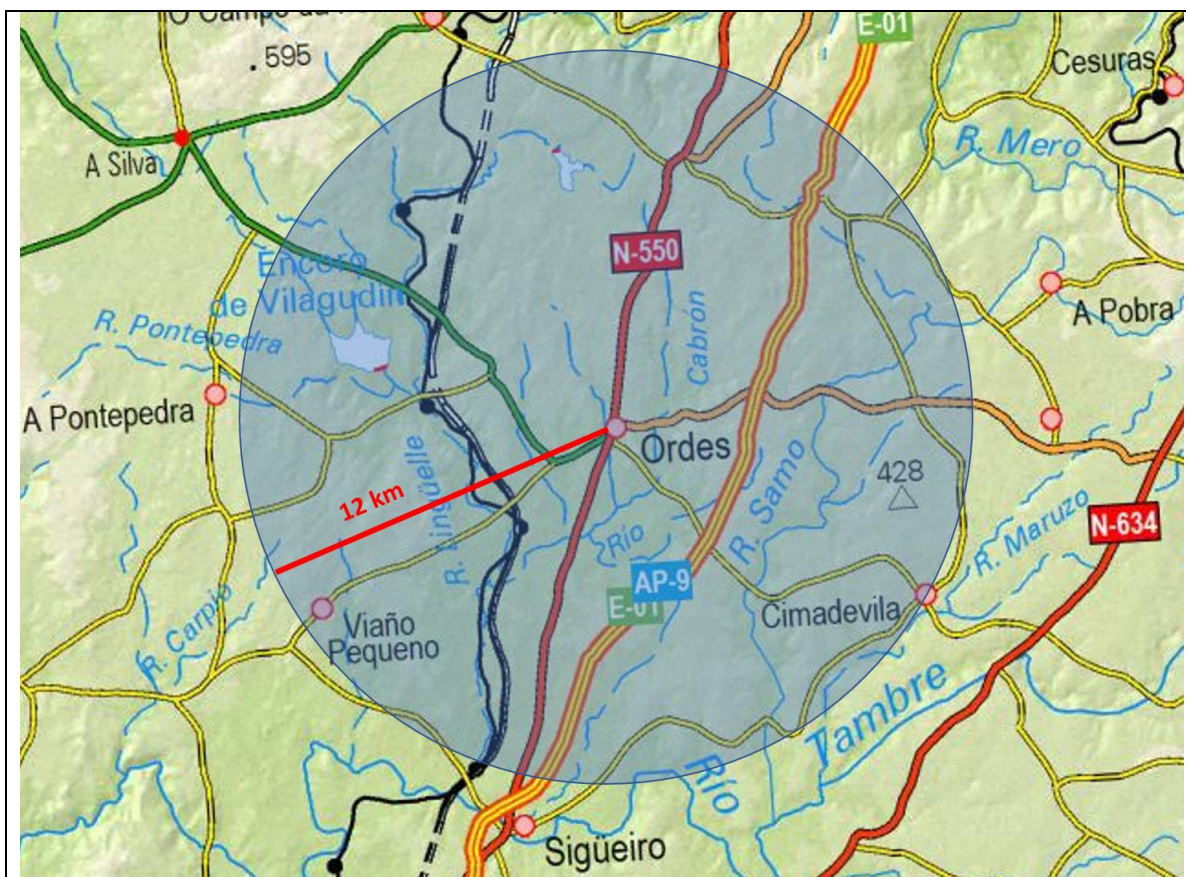

### FREE PRACTICE

This stage is reserved for all participating Teams with Rally2, R5 y N5 vehicles, exceptt for those participating in a Cup authorised by the RFEDA. For Teams participating in Qualifying Stage, this Stage will replace the shakedown.

Competitors may complete a maximum of 2 passages of practice, and will start with an interval of 1 minute.

### SHAKEDOWN

This Stage is reserved for Drivers not eligible for the Qualifying Stage, who are not required to register and participate in it.

Competitors may complete a maximum of 3 passages of practice, and will start with an interval of 30 seconds or 1 minute at the discretion of Race Direction

## 24 QUALIFYING STAGE (Art. 22.2.1 CERT-Rallycar Sporting Regulations)

The eligible drivers will start the Qualifying Stage with 1 minute gap interval between each car, excepting Stewards' against decision.

The starting order will be in increasing numerical order.

A starting list with time of presentation at time control previous to Qualifying Stage will be published in the programme (SR. Art. 3).

A starting list with time of presentation at time control previous to Qualifying Stage will be published in the programme (SR. Art. 3).



Time card for the Qualifying stage will be issued on the start time control of Free Practice. In case of not taking the start at Free Practice, the participant must present himself at the scheduled time for its entry at the Time Control, where he will be given the Time Card.

The stipulated procedures for the start of a special stage will apply.

Competitors that don't turn up on time the previous TC won't take part in the Qualifying Stage.

Qualifying Stage will be timed to the thousand.

In the event of a dead heat, the competitors will be classified according to the start order to this Qualifying Stage.

Any car which breaks down during the Qualifying stage or during the following road section will be towed to the Parc Fermé by the organizers once the Qualifying stage has finished.

All cars which participate in the Qualifying stage must immediately and directly be brought to the Parc Fermé and remain there until released by the Stewards.

Any service on a car once it has finished the Qualifying stage to it has arrived to Parc Fermé is forbidden. Any competitor failing to comply will be subject to a penalty at Stewards' discretion.

## 26 CÓDIGO MEDIO AMBIENTAL

The rules and recommendations prescribed in the Environmental Code of the Royal Spanish Motor Sport Federation, and especially those contained in point 1.9, are recalled in order to improve the relationship between motorsport and the environment.





## ANEXO I – DISPOSICIONES COMPLEMENTARIAS

### 1th. SOS' Emergency phone number

The organizer will give each participant two stickers with the emergency telephone number, which the contestants or the public can call in case of an emergency or an accident that occurred during the Rally. These stickers will be placed on participating vehicles, one inside and one outside, both in clearly visible places.

Calls made through the emergency phone will be recorded for security.

### 2th. Tyres

The tires used in the Shakedown/Free Practice, Qualifying Stage and SS X (Show Stage) will not be marked nor will they count towards the maximum number to be used during the rally.

### 3th. Entry at time controls in advance

Participants are authorized to enter in advance of the scheduled time without incurring a penalty in the:

- TC QF (Qualifying ending)
- TC 8c (Rally arrival)

### 4th. Contact and availability of the participants

During administrative checks, all participants must communicate the mobile phone number that both crew members will carry on board the vehicle and that must remain operational throughout the Rally, until the publication of the official final classification or the notification of definitive abandonment of the event.

### 5th. Competitors Safety

In the event of stopping in a timed section, the team must signal its status to the rest of the participants, in a visible way, showing the OK/SOS signal inserted in the Road Book or by means of the manual signals shown below. They must also mark the vehicle with the regulatory triangle.



### 6th. Crane Service

The crane service contracted by the organization is at its service, under the instructions of the race direction and is exclusively intended to clear the path of obstacles. Any other type of service must be contracted by the participating teams directly with the companies that own the cranes
